The time I had used in transit, I now devoted to searching for game-changers in different fields, experts dealing with digital transformation, and finding like-minded souls. I discovered healing and more efficient intuitive lifestyle. During my search, I found this book's featured talent and artist, Caroline Cunningham, who shared my fascination for old doors and expressing creativity.

'The In Between' may represent different possibilities to the viewer. My intention was to acknowledge that timeless place where we are fully present and connected to Nature itself.

In a small town in Rajasthan, I came upon this vibrant doorway, with large white painted Hindi script painted across its doors. I decided to include it in my 'Indian Heart Way' painting collection. I wanted to apply different Hindi words to the doors, to portray the theme of my collection.

After some research, I settled on the phrase 'Dilieri ka Rasta.' Much later I discovered that this phrase has a more particular meaning, pertaining to the path of the courageous female heart. I confess I misplaced the order of the words in the phrase I chose. So all viewers, including Hindi speakers, may share my own experience of seeing that original doorway, with a script I could not decipher, giving rise to so much curiosity.






The Dreaming Doors
