My Testimony

About 20 years ago, I started my life journey that led me to write this book. Then I was just a 13 years-old lonely schoolboy. I was born to Christian parents in 1988 whose background was in the Pentecostal movement. But I was ashamed of my Pentecostal background and afraid to expose it to my classmates. But when I was some 11, I read the shocking words of our Lord and Savior from the Gospel of Luke: *"For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when He comes in His glory and the glory of the Father and the holy angels."*¹ I was still afraid of my schoolmates' reactions if they could find out that I am a "Jesus freak", but I

was a more afraid of God, the Creator of the Universe, and the King of Kings. So, I did something really hair-raising: I bought a large 3-4 inches crucifix and hung it up on my neck and went to my school with it.

As I could have already expected, my schoolmates were not very happy about it. Immediately after that, I got the nickname "Jesus". Whenever I was around, they were jesting, "Hey, look, *Jesus* is here". "*Is Jesus a king?*", one was asking in a mocking tone. When there was a swimming lesson, they were joking again, "Hey, *Jesus*, can you teach us how to walk on water". Yeah, funny. But it was not very funny to me, especially when they are not laughing *with* you but *at* you. So, my school years were quite a lonely and humiliating experience. But with humiliation, you learn *humility*, so maybe it was a valuable experience after all. This background may also explain why I got very bad school grades, why I was a truant, and why I terminated my school before High School.

By the way, at this point, it may be good to clarify that I am a Finn. The Finnish education system is not identical with the American one, but in Finnish, "lukio" corresponds to almost American High School, so I use that expression here. I got good grades only in music and visual arts. In all other school subjects, I got the lowest ones. And those included the English language which is an obligatory subject in Finland. That's why it is nothing less than a *miracle* that I am writing a book in English right now. Of course, I could have not done it without the help of the Internet and such handy apps as Grammarly (no, they do not pay for me). After my difficult school years, I could not get a job, because I had some mental problems like diagnosed OCD that caused me to be late in every job I tried (I had this same problem in my school). So I ended up becoming a "welfare bum" of the Finnish welfare state. I felt that I was just a burden of our society, so I was thinking to take my own life many times. I had

no friends, no social life, no girlfriend, or paid work. But maybe I got some supernatural strength from the words of that Jewish man who said:

If anyone wants to come after Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it.²

Another thing that kept me alive was this clear sense of calling and duty. I had been interested in Biblical eschatology since I was a little boy. But about 20 years ago I started to study this idea and theory on the biblical identity of the *final* Antichrist about which a few web pages and American Jewish students of the biblical eschatology, Monte Judah, and Tim Cohen, had written about in the 1990s. I bought and read Tim Cohen's 1998 book *The Antichrist and a Cup of Tea* on the subject in 2008. Later, I have been in contact with Tim, and he is working on the second, expanded, and updated edition of that book right now. I recommend that you read also that book after he publishes it.

About ten years ago, in 2012, I started to write my first book on my eschatological studies in my Finnish mother tongue. I finished... I mean finished that book that had swollen into 700 A4 pages in December 2014, and in January 2015, I published it on my new website and blog. It was too large, so I could not get it published. But I was already expecting that, so it was not a big shock to me. A well-known Finnish veteran speaker and a teacher of prophecy and Scriptures in general, Leo Meller, to whom I sent that massive manuscript, sent me a very encouraging email, so that was enough to me. I felt that I had fulfilled my whole life's purpose or that Holy Spirit had led me to write that book for that moment. For the first time, I felt that my life had some purpose, and I was not just a burden of our society.

After that, I started to write countless blog articles and published some edited YouTube videos (by the way, I recommend checking out also my

YouTube Channel that you find by my name). In January 2019, I wrote a more condensed version of that 700-page manuscript and published it as my first printed book in print-on-demand format via the same publisher as this book is published. The book that you are reading is an English version of that Finnish book. But even though the subject of every Chapter is basically the same, I have rewritten it completely. To this day, I have published in my blog and books, this one included, about 1.4 million words. In this book, you have about 150,000 words, so if all that text I have produced during the past decade were to be put between the covers, I would have written 10 as thick books as this one.

Not a bad achievement for a “welfare bum” (and during my school years it was a great challenge for me to write one to two-page essays on some subject). Besides my faith, I have got strength from many friends and readers who have encouraged me during all these years. One of my closest friends was my own big brother Mikael... yes *was*. On December 14, 2020, my family and I received grieving news: my dear brother had taken his own life after six months of severe depression, anxiety, and insomnia. My brother was a believer in our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Yeshua Hamashiach, who conquered death on the Cross of Calvary and who has “the keys of death and of Hades.”³ So I have firm confidence and peace in my heart that we will meet again in Heaven.

Like Apostle Paul said: *“Who will bring charges against God’s elect? God is the one who justifies; who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, but rather, was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us. Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or trouble, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?... For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”*⁴

At one point I was suicidal myself, so I can relate with those who feel bottomless despair and who have no strength left to struggle. Many prophets in the Bible felt this same desperation. Jeremiah wrote: *“Cursed be the day when I was born; May the day when my mother gave birth to me not be blessed!”*⁵ Job wrote in his despair; *“May the day on which I was to be born perish, as well as the night which said, ‘a boy is conceived... Why did I not die at birth, come out of the womb and pass away? Why were the knees there in front of me, and why the breasts, that I would nurse? For now, I would have lain down and been quiet; I would have slept then, I would have been at rest, with kings and counselors of the earth, who rebuilt ruins for themselves; or with rulers who had gold, who were filling their houses with silver... my cries pour out like water. For what I fear comes upon me, and what I dread encounters me. I am not at ease, nor am I quiet, and I am not at rest, but turmoil comes.”*⁶

The message of Christianity is not to pretend that there would not have a lot of suffering, injustice, and evil in the world. It is rather to answer *why* there is so much suffering in the world, and how our God became one with His Creation, in His Son Jesus Christ, to take the death, suffering, and sin – that our sins and rebellion against God had caused – upon Himself so that He could atone for our transgressions against God, Creation, our neighbors, and ourselves. So that He could show to us His unconditional love for us as His Image, as His Children, that He created each and every one of us.

When I received news of my dear brother’s passing, initially I was mad at God. *Why did He allow this to happen?* After all, many had prayed for my brother’s despair in Finland and abroad. *How weak and pathetic our God really is.* Some ungodly pitiless people were putting even laughing emojis on my brother’s death on Facebook and commenting sarcastically on the “power of prayer”. But like Job, to whom God spoke in his despair and grieving, eventually understood that God is God in His Wisdom, Majesty and Glory even then when

we do not understand Him, I did also raise my hands in the air and worshipped Him who - in the words of Natalie Grant's song *Praise You In This Storm* - "gives and takes away". As lyrics of this powerful song continues:

And I'll praise You in this storm
And I will lift my hands
Cause You are who You are
No matter where I am
And every tear I've cried
You hold in Your hand
You never left my side
And though my heart is torn
I will praise You in this storm

When God was hanging on the Cross of Calvary, He indeed did look very weak and pathetic to many of us. The Savior of mankind? *"He cannot save [even] Himself!"*, as Pharisees mocked Him. *"He is the King of Israel; let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe in Him. He has trusted in God; let God rescue Him now, if He takes pleasure in Him; for He said, 'I am the Son of God.'"*

⁷ I am sure that I was looking as weak and pathetic to my schoolmates when I was this bullied, lonely, and quiet schoolboy. I *could not even walk on water* to prove that Jesus is indeed the King of Kings. But sometimes God's greatest power is shown in the midst of a seeming weakness and His greatest love is shown to us at the darkest hour of our life. To the end, I want to cite this beautiful prophecy I got from a brother in Christ in Summer 2020 when I was asking him to pray for my big brother:

I have prayed for your brother. I received a message from the Lord in prayer to you, "Before you were born of a mother, I chose you, called and separated you, as I called and separated Jeremiah (Jer. 1:5, Gal. 1:15). For I had already seen your humble spirit, and beforehand I saw how you tremble at My Word. I have given you the skill to put biblical prophecy into words, in a form that people can understand. It is your gift, received from Me. As I said to Jeremiah, so I say to you; You have

seen well (Jer. 1:12) Soon the Antichrist is going to appear on the face of the whole world; I have revealed him to you, and I will continue to reveal great, hidden things (Jer. 33: 3). I will bless your ministry as I have blessed you so far. With these words, I want to strengthen you. You are dear to me, know it, very dear. In Me, you will live an abundant life, (John 10:10) I give you a future and hope. future (Jer. 29:11). My Spirit will help you in your writing, I will speak My thoughts unto your heart. Don't worry about anything secular, livelihood, or anything else. But seek My Kingdom first, and all these things shall be given to you. I am your portion (Lam. 3:24). Words of the Lord are pure words; Like silver refined in a furnace on the ground, filtered seven times (Psalm 12:6).
