This book is the second edition of the book called "Kumous" in Finnish and thus, is the real intended work, partly because of the nature of my work itself, which had to be written in some more common language and partly due to the process of learning and error correction. The original book was published in Finnish in October 2008 and it has some errors in it that I know of so far:

- 1.) A. S. Neill was a Scotsman and I had wrongly said that he was an American.
- 2.) V. I. Lenin's economical program is called NEP and I had put in the additional P (NEPP).
- 3.) In the Finnish book, on page 31 there is a quotation, which is not accurate by word. It is condensed from Marx's text.
- 4.) The communistic manifest is the communistic party's manifest.
- 5.) All unnecessary repetition is taken out to make the book clearer and more readable. In general, this version is sharper and more focused.

Also, I must mention that all quotation is freely translated from Finnish into English, except the parts taken from "the Empire," so there may very well be minor oddities.

It took me over 2 years to write this work but studying took a couple of decades.
