

THE

The artwork explores authorship through filming and texts. The illustrations that fit into everyday life are appropriate and create new meanings in both contexts. Throughout the work, new benefits, perspectives, and meanings emerge, and the artbook material fosters the development of professional skills. Each photo poem is accompanied by text.

Both public transport and private vehicles present possibilities for sustainable development. The scent of the pine forest is striking — and deeply inspiring. Keini depicts both nature and urban streetscapes, combining them with Italian texts and illustrations. Are you inspired by the smell of the pine forest? Do you appreciate both nature and the city, whether from near or from afar?

Mirka Keini holds a Master of Arts degree and is an artist, writer, language teacher, and poetry event producer based in Helsinki. She is the author of four self-published works, the most recent of which is titled Audiobooklike I (2022). Keini's artist name is Mira Mink.

Keini has worked on artistic projects, including organizing art exhibitions and combining music with poetry in performances and open-stage events. A primary inspiration for her artistic work is the promotion of learning.
